Jay Peak Resort

Located on Jay Peak in Vermont's Green Mountains, is home to some of the East's best terrain providing skiers and riders with amazing tree glades, long groomed trails, and abundant natural snowfall (average 349" a season). The resort lies just south of the Canadian border near the town of Jay, Vermont.

The area has 385 acres of terrain and offers a great mix of beginner to advanced trails, (26% beginner, 50% intermediate, and 24% advanced), all connected by an updated chairlift system. The ski area contains a large snow making infrastructure able to cover a majority of the resort.

Lodging:

The club will be staying at the Stateside Hotel. This is the newest property at Jay Peak which opened in 2014. The hotel offers ski-in, ski-out access. There is an on-site rental shop and ski school. For your apres ski and dining there is an on-site restaurant (Howie's), bar (Bullwheel), and hot tub. Rooms have a coffee maker, microwave, mini fridge and free WiFi. There is a free shuttle to get you to other parts of the resort.

Trip Regulations

1. Prices are based on double occupancy. An additional individual in a room without notifying the club in advance is prohibited. Should the club and/or hotel become aware that an additional individual is in the room the responsible club member will be liable for any additional room fees. These fees will be paid to the hotel prior to checkout using the credit card provided at check-in.
2. I agree to comply with the payment schedule presented for the trip and acknowledge that failure to make payments in a timely manner could result in my being removed from the trip, with penalties.
