Vail Ski Resort is the second largest single resort in North America with 5,317 acres of the most diverse and expansive skiing in the world, blessed with over 300 days of sunshine a year. Vail Mountain is accessed by three base areas: Lionshead, Vail Village, and Golden Peak.

Stretching for 7 miles (11km) and served by 32 lifts, eight of them express quads; it has over 120 named trails. Expert skiers and powder fanatics have plenty of challenging terrain on Vail's Front side as well as the seven legendary 'Back Bowls.'
